## **Telecom Regulatory Authority of India**

On 6th July 2024, the Mobile Number Portability (MNP) requests processed in the country since January 2011 crossed the 100 crore (1 Billion) mark.

**New Delhi, 26**<sup>th</sup> **July 2024** — Mobile Number Portability (MNP) was introduced in India on 20<sup>th</sup> January 2011, in accordance with Telecommunication Mobile Number Portability Regulations, 2009 issued by the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI). The MNP allows a telecom subscriber to retain his mobile number when switching from one service provider to another, anywhere in the country. At present, about 11 million porting requests are processed in a month in India.
