TRAI releases consultation paper on Market Structure/ Competition in cable TV services

New Delhi, 25 October 2021 - The Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) has today issued the consultation paper on Market Structure/Competition in cable TV services.

- 2. Ministry of Information and Broadcasting (MIB) vide its letter dated 12th December 2012 had sought recommendations of the Authority (TRAI) on the issues related to monopoly/market dominance in the cable TV services. After following a due consultation process, TRAI issued its recommendations on Monopoly/Market dominance in the cable TV services on 26th November 2013 (Recommendations are available on www.trai.gov.in).
- 3. TRAI has now received a back reference dated 19th February 2021 from MIB mentioning therein that a considerable time has passed since the recommendations were made and that the media and entertainment (M&E) landscape has changed drastically, particularly with the advent of new digital technologies in this sector, and, therefore, MIB felt that some of the issues need further consideration by the Authority and it may provide a fresh set of recommendations matter looking in the at the subsequent developments/expansion in the M&E sector.
- 4. Accordingly, TRAI has issued this consultation paper on Market Structure/Competition in cable TV services.
