- ❖ In the month of April, 2023, 10.95 million subscribers submitted their requests for Mobile Number Portability (MNP). With this, the cumulative MNP requests increased from 819.70 million at the end of March-23 to 830.65 million at the end of April-23, since implementation of MNP.
- ❖ Number of active wireless subscribers (on the date of peak VLR#) in April, 2023 was 1038.45 million.

I. Broadband Subscriber

- As per the information received from 1,011 operators in April, 2023 in comparison to 1,007 Operator in March 2023, the total Broadband Subscribers increased from 846.57

million at the end of March-23 to 850.94 million at the end of April-23 with a monthly growth rate of 0.52%. Segment-wise broadband subscribers and their monthly growth rates are as below: -

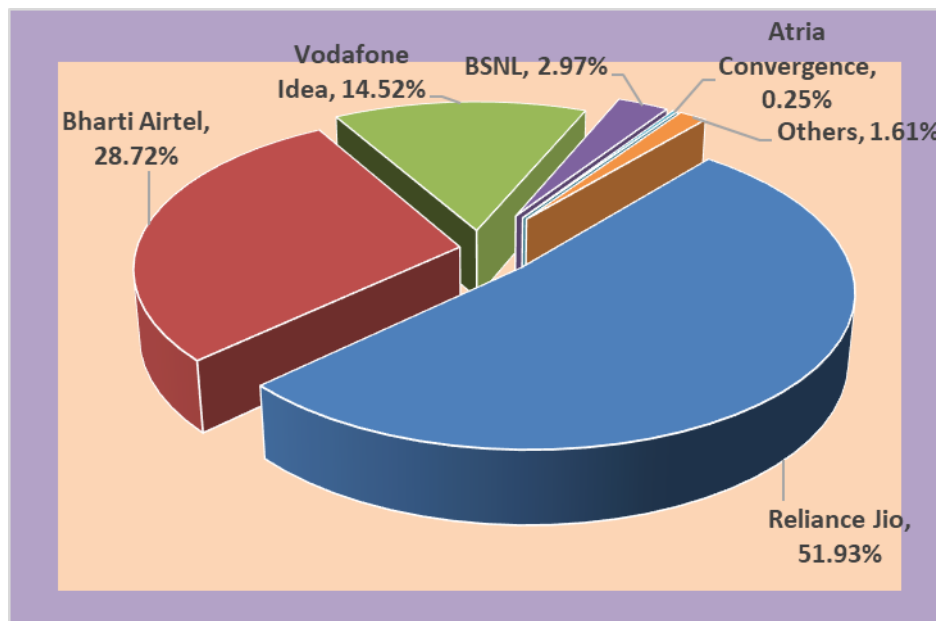

- Top five service providers constituted 98.39% market share of the total broadband subscribers at the end of April-23. These service providers were Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd 441.92 million, Bharti Airtel 244.37 million, Vodafone Idea 123.58 million, BSNL 25.26 million and Atria Convergence 2.14 million.

(wired + wireless) Services as on 30th April, 2023**

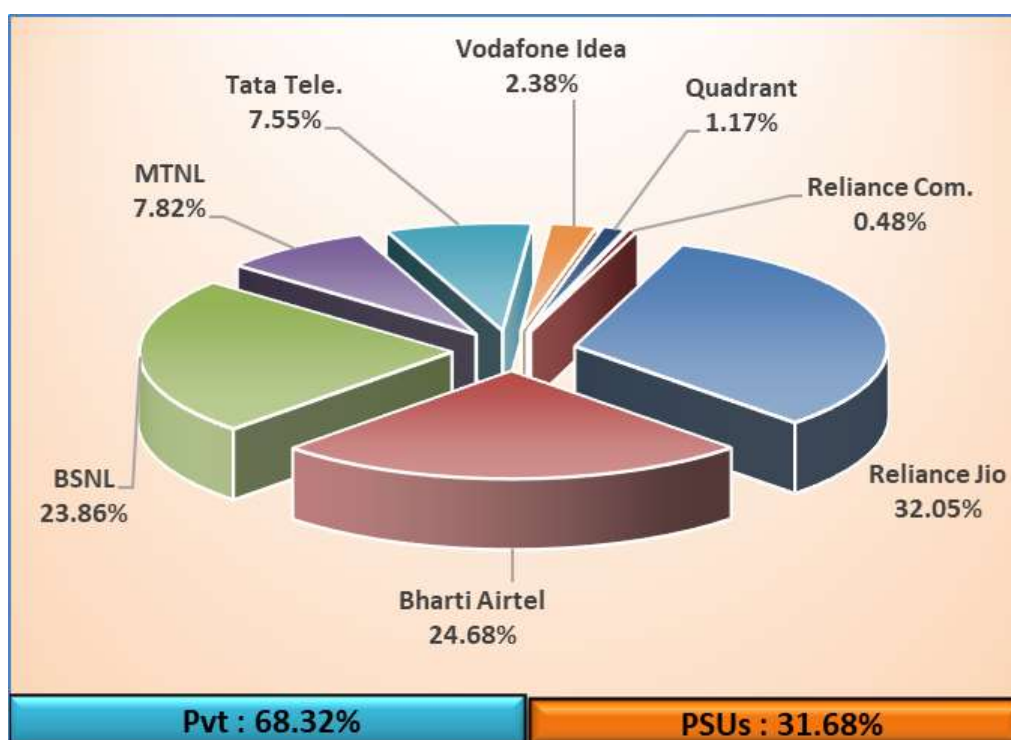


- As on 30th April, 2023, the top five Wired Broadband Service providers were Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd 8.65 million, Bharti Airtel 6.25 million, BSNL 3.63 million, Atria Convergence Technologies 2.14 million and Hathway Cable & Datacom 1.12 million.
- As on 30th April, 2023, the top five Wireless Broadband Service providers were Reliance Jio Infocom Ltd 433.27 million, Bharti Airtel 238.11 million, Vodafone Idea 123.57 million, BSNL 21.63 million and Intech Online Pvt. Ltd. 0.24 million.

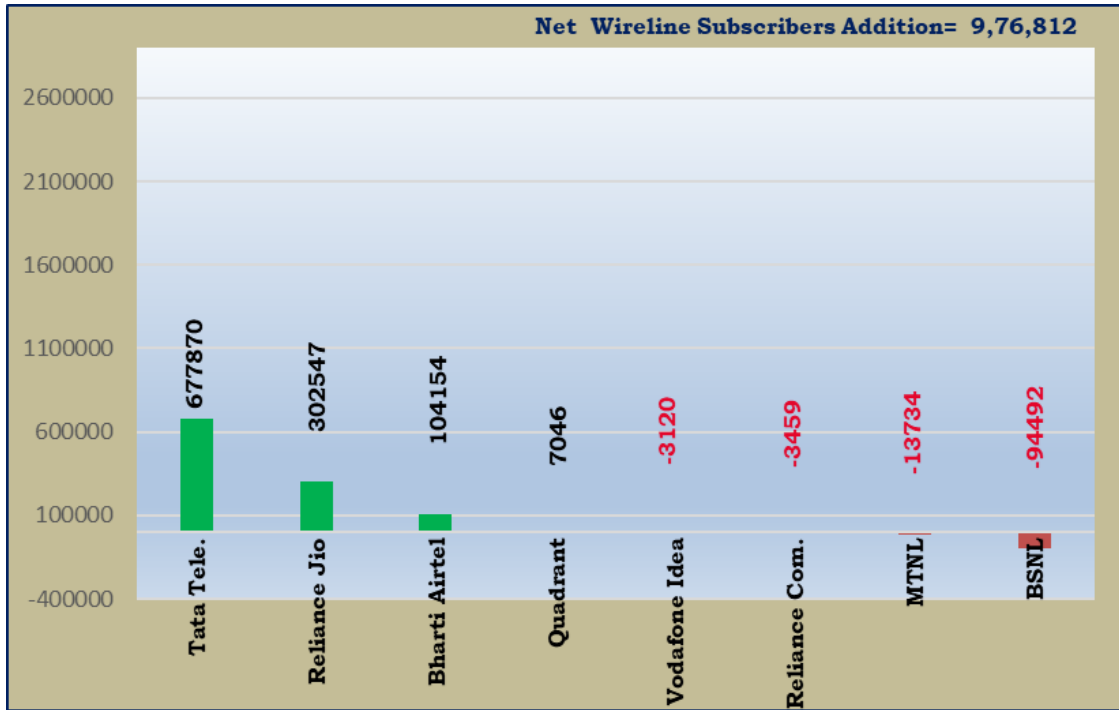
II. Wireline Subscribers

- Wireline subscribers increased from 28.41 million at the end of March-23 to 29.39 million at the end of April-23. Net increase in the wireline subscriber base was 0.98 million with a monthly growth rate of 3.44%. The share of urban and rural subscribers in total wireline subscribers were 92.35% and 7.65% respectively at the end of April, 2023.
- The Overall Wireline Tele-density in India increased from 2.05% at the end of March-23 to 2.12% at the end of April-23. Urban and Rural Wireline Tele-density were 5.55% and 0.25% respectively during the same period.
- BSNL and MTNL, the two PSU access service providers, held 31.68% of the wireline market share as on 30th April, 2023. Detailed statistics of wireline subscriber base are available at **Annexure-I**.

III. Wireless subscriber

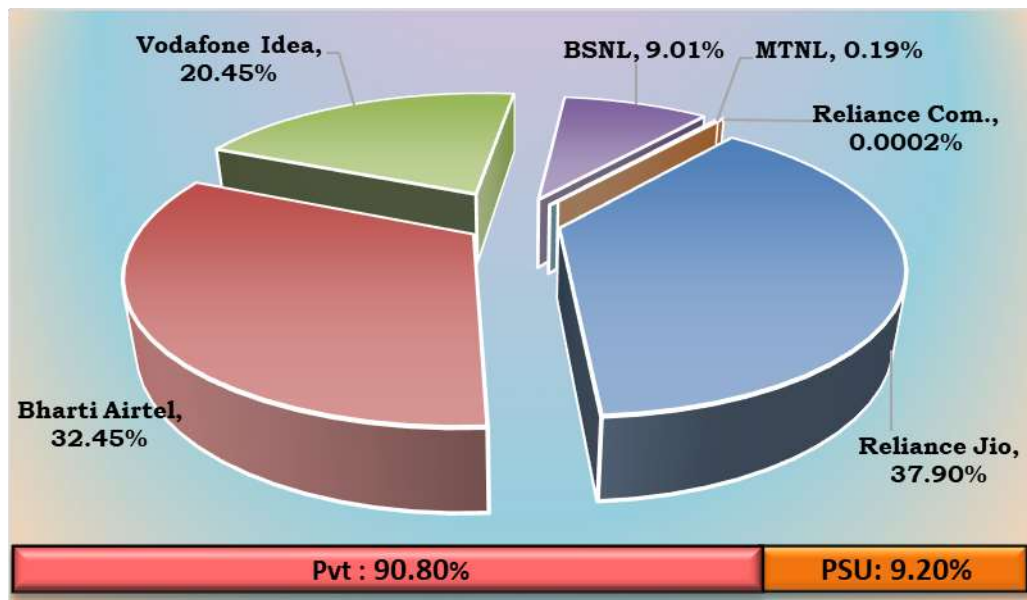
• Total wireless subscribers decreased from 1,143.93 million at the end of March-23, to 1,143.13 million at the end of April-23, thereby registering a monthly decline rate of 0.07%. Wireless subscription in urban areas decreased from 627.54 million at the end of March-23 to 626.74 million at the end of April-23 however wireless subscription in rural areas increased from 516.38 million to 516.39 million during the same period. Monthly growth rate of urban and rural wireless subscription was -0.13% and 0.00% respectively.



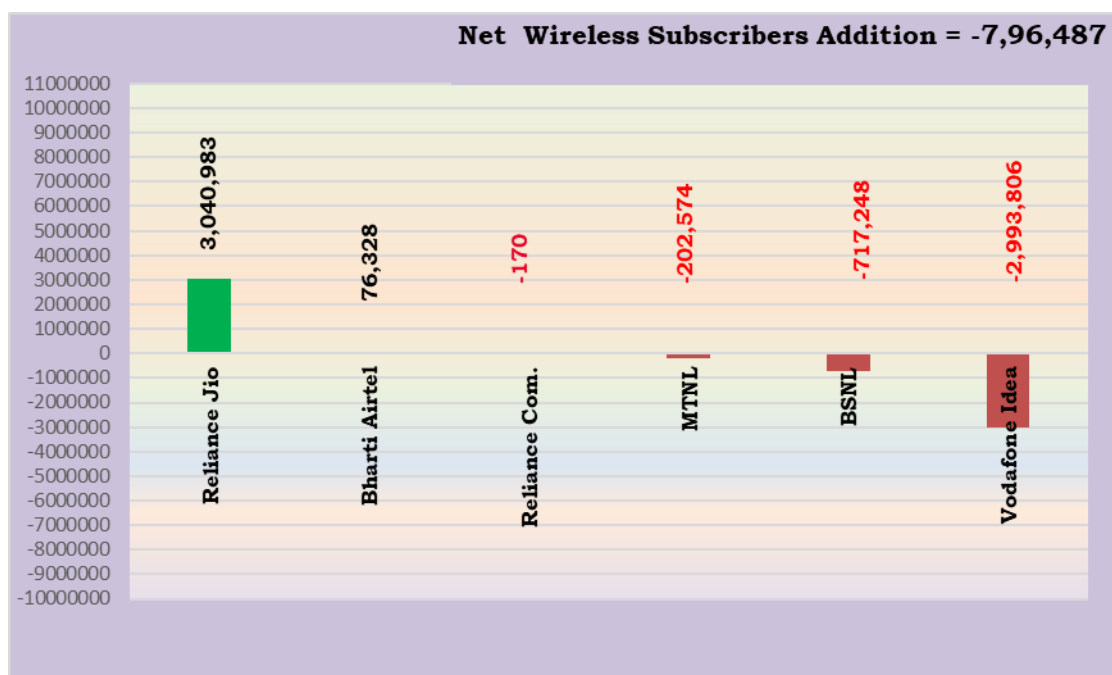
• The Wireless Tele-density in India decreased from 82.46% at the end of March-23 to 82.34% at the end of April-23. The Urban Wireless Tele-density decreased from 128.45% at the end of March-23 to 128.09% at the end of April-23 and Rural Tele-density also decreased from 57.46% to 57.44% during the same period. The share of urban and rural wireless subscribers in total number of wireless subscribers was 54.83% and 45.17% respectively at the end of April-23. Detailed statistics of wireless subscriber base is available at **Annexure-II**.

- As on 30th April, 2023, the private access service providers held 90.80% market share of the wireless subscribers whereas BSNL and MTNL, the two PSU access service providers, had a market share of only 9.20%.

- Except Bihar, Assam, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, J&K, U.P.(E), Odisha, Gujarat and Andhra Pradesh, all other service areas have showed decline in their wireless subscribers during the month of April-23.

IV. Total Telephone Subscribers

- The number of telephone subscribers in India increased from 1,172.34 million at the end of March-23 to 1,172.52 million at the end of April-23, thereby showing a monthly growth rate of 0.02%. Urban telephone subscription increased from 653.71 million at the end of March-23 to 653.88 million at the end of April-23 and the rural subscription also increased from 518.63 million to 518.64 million during the same period. The monthly growth rates of urban and rural telephone subscription were 0.03% and 0.00% respectively during the month of April-23.



- The overall Tele-density in India decreased 84.51% at the end of March-23 to 84.46% at the end of April-23. The Urban Tele-density decreased from 133.81% at the end of March-23 to 133.64% at the end of April-23 and Rural Tele-density also decreased from 57.71% to 57.69% during the same period. The share of urban and rural subscribers in total number of telephone subscribers at the end of April-23 was 55.77% and 44.23% respectively.

Overall Tele-density (LSA Wise) – As on 30th April, 2023



- As may be seen in the above chart, eight LSA have less tele-density than the all India average tele-density at the end of April-23. Delhi service area has maximum tele-density of 273.32% and the Bihar service area has minimum tele-density of 55.50% at the end of April-23.

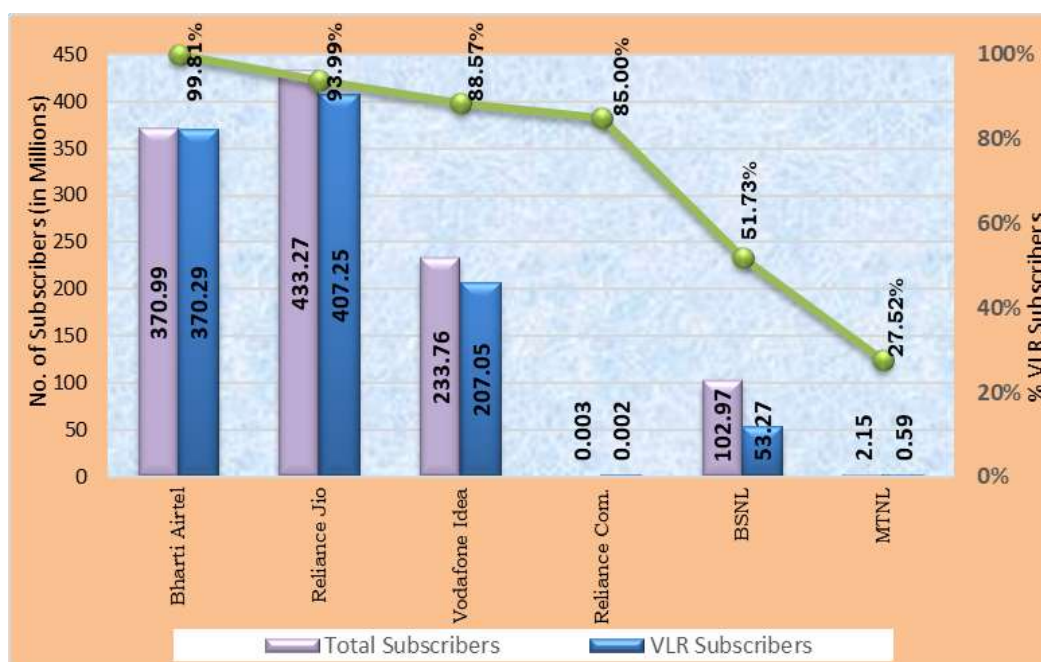

- As can be seen in the above tables, in wireless segment, on monthly basis except Circle 'C', all other circles have registered decline rate in their subscriber base. On yearly basis, except Circle 'A' and Circle 'B' other circles have registered growth rate in their subscriber base.
- In Wireline segment both on monthly and yearly basis, all circles have registered growth rate in their subscriber base.

VI. Active Wireless Subscribers (VLR Data)

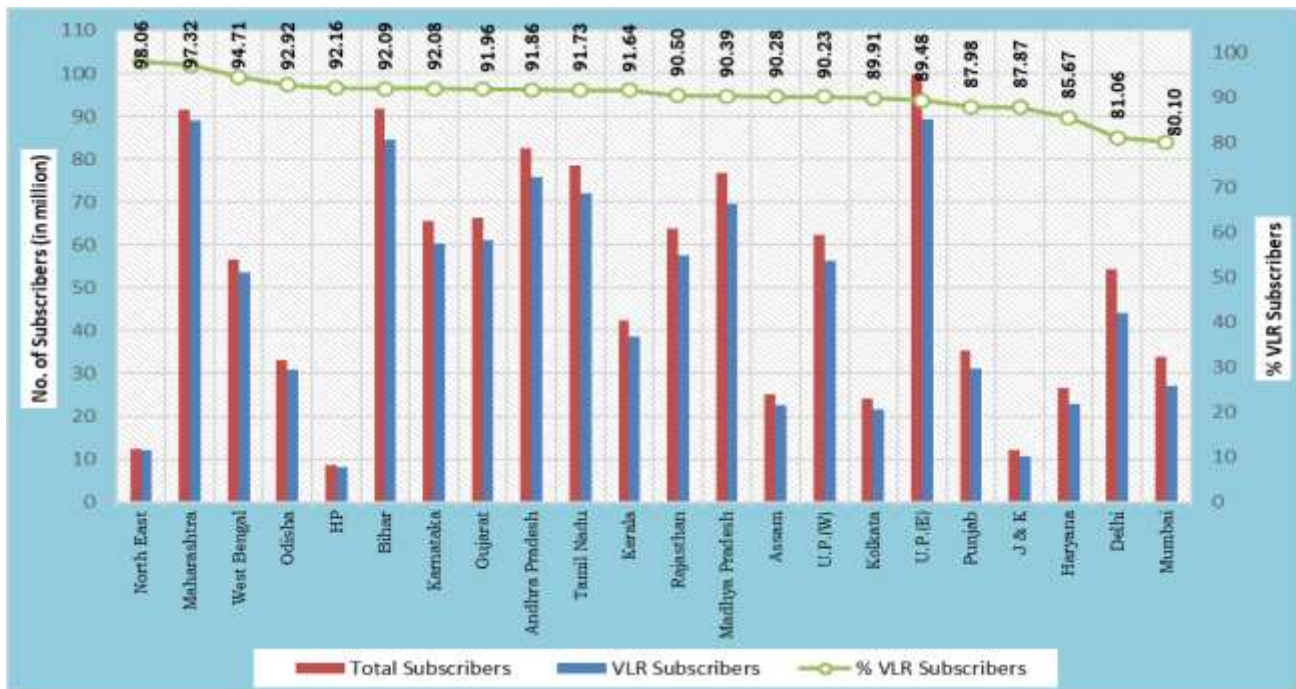
- Out of the total 1,143.13 million wireless subscribers, 1038.45 million wireless subscribers were active on the date of peak VLR in the month of April-23. The proportion of active wireless subscribers was approximately 90.84% of the total wireless subscriber base.
- The detailed statistics on proportion of active wireless subscribers (also referred to as VLR subscribers) on the date of peak VLR in the month of April-23 is available at **Annexure-III** and the methodology used for reporting VLR subscribers is available at **Annexure-IV**.

- Bharti Airtel has the maximum proportion 99.81% of its active wireless subscribers (VLR) as against its total wireless subscribers (HLR) on the date of peak VLR in the month of April-23 and MTNL has the minimum proportion of VLR 27.52% of its HLR during the same period.

VII. Mobile Number Portability (MNP)

- Intra-service area Mobile number portability (MNP) was implemented first in Haryana service area w.e.f. 25.11.2010 and in the rest of the country w.e.f. 20.01.2011. Inter-Service Area MNP has been implemented in the country w.e.f. 03.07.2015. Now, the wireless telephone subscribers can retain their mobile numbers when they relocate from one service area to another.
- During the month of April-23, a total of 10.95 million requests were received for MNP. Out of total 10.95 million new requests, 6.31 million requests received from Zone-I and 4.64 million requests received from Zone-II. The cumulative MNP requests increased from 819.70 million at the end of March-23 to 830.65 million at the end of April-23, since the implementation of MNP.
- In MNP Zone-I (Northern and Western India), the highest number of requests till date have been received in Uttar Pradesh-East (about 72.33 million) followed by Maharashtra (about 68.52 million) service area.

- In MNP Zone-II (Southern and Eastern India), the highest number of requests till date have been received in Madhya Pradesh (about 63.04 million) followed by Karnataka (about 60.46 million).

VLR Subscribers in the Wireless Segment

Home Location Register (HLR) is a central database that contains details of each mobile phone subscriber that is authorized to use the GSM core network. The HLRs store details of every SIM card issued by the service provider. Each SIM has a unique identifier called an International Mobile Subscriber Identity (IMSI), which is the primary key to each HLR record. The HLR data is stored for as long as a subscriber remains with the service provider. HLR also manages the mobility of subscribers by means of updating their position in administrative areas. It sends the subscriber data to a Visitor Location Register (VLR).

Subscriber numbers reported by the service providers is the difference between the numbers of IMSI registered in service provider's HLR and sum of other figures as given below: -

Visitor Location Register (VLR) is a temporary database of the subscribers who have roamed into the particular area, which it serves. Each base station in the network is served by exactly one VLR; hence a subscriber cannot be present in more than one VLR at a time.

If subscriber is in active stage i.e. he is able to send/receive calls/SMSs he is available both in HLR and VLR. However, it may be possible that the subscriber is registered in HLR but not in VLR due to the reason that he is either switched-off or moved out of coverage area, not reachable etc. In such circumstances he will be available in HLR but not in VLR. This causes difference between subscriber number reported by the service providers based on HLR and numbers available in VLR.

The VLR subscriber data calculated here is based on active subscribers in VLR on the date of Peak subscriber number in VLR of the particular month for which the data is being collected. This data is to be taken from the switches having the purge time of not more than 72 hours.
