

Executive Summary

1. The number of telephone subscribers in India declined from 1,197.87 million at the end of Dec-18 to 1,183.51 million at the end of Mar-19, registering a decline rate of 1.20% over the previous quarter. This reflects year-on-year (Y-O-Y) decline rate of 1.88% over the same quarter of last year. The overall Teledensity¹ in India declined from 91.45 as on QE Dec-18 to 90.11 as on QE Mar-19.

Trends in Telephone subscribers and Teledensity in India




2. Telephone subscription in Urban areas increased from 666.28 million at the end of Dec-18 to 669.16 million at the end of Mar-19 however, Urban Teledensity slightly declined from 159.98 to 159.96 during the same period.
3. Rural telephone subscription declined from 531.59 million at the end of Dec-18 to 514.35 million at the end of Mar-19 and Rural Teledensity also declined from 59.50 at the end of Dec-18 to 57.47 at the end of Mar-19.

¹ Teledensity – Number of telephone connections (fixed lines and mobile phone subscribers) per 100 inhabitants within a geographical area.


4. Out of the total subscription, the share of Rural subscription declined from 44.38% at the end of Dec-18 to 43.46% at the end of Mar-19.

5. With a net decline of 14.19 million subscribers during the quarter, total wireless (GSM incl. LTE + CDMA) subscriber base declined from 1,176.00 million at the end of Dec-18 to 1,161.81 million at the end of Mar-19, registering a decline rate of 1.21% over the previous quarter. Wireless subscriptions declined year-on-year (Y-O-Y) at the rate of 1.82% during the quarter.
6. Wireless Tele-density declined from 89.78 at the end of Dec-18 to 88.46 at the end of Mar-19.
7. Wireline subscriber declined from 21.87 million at the end of Dec-18 to 21.70 million at the end of Mar-19 with quarterly decline rate of 0.79%. The year-on-year (Y-O-Y) decline rate in wireline subscribers for Mar-19 is 4.89%.
8. Wireline Teledensity also declined from 1.67 at the end of Dec-18 to 1.65 at the end of Mar-19.

9. Total number of Internet² subscribers increased from 604.21 million at the end of Dec-18 to 636.73 million at the end of Mar-19, registering a quarterly growth rate of 5.38%. Out of 636.73 million internet subscribers, number of Wired Internet subscribers are 21.68 million and number of Wireless Internet subscribers are 615.05 million.



10. The Internet subscriber base is comprised of Broadband³ Internet subscriber base of 563.31 million and Narrowband⁴ Internet subscriber base of 73.42 million.
11. The broadband Internet subscriber base increased by 7.22% from 525.36 million at the end of Dec-18 to 563.31 million at the end of Mar-19. However, the narrowband Internet subscriber base declined by 6.89% from 78.86 million at the end of Dec-18 to 73.42 million at the end of Mar-19.

² Internet: Interconnected global networks that use the internet protocol.

³ Broadband: Internet access with a minimum capacity of greater or equal 512 Kbit/s in one or both directions.

⁴ Narrowband: Internet access with a capacity of less than 512 Kbit/s in one or both directions.

12. Monthly Average Revenue per User (ARPU)⁵ for wireless service increased by 1.80%, from ₹70.13 in QE Dec-18 to ₹71.39 in QE Mar-19. However, monthly ARPU for wireless service declined by 6.12% on yearly basis (Y-O-Y) in this quarter.

13. Prepaid ARPU per month increased from ₹60 in QE Dec-18 to ₹63 in QE Mar-19, however Postpaid ARPU per month declined from ₹296 in QE Dec-18 to ₹261 in QE Mar-19.

14. On an all India average, the overall Minutes of Usage (MOU)⁶ per subscriber per month for wireless service increased by 3.74% from 667 for QE Dec-18 to 692 in QE Mar-19.

15. Prepaid MOU per subscriber per month increased from 666 in QE Dec-18 to 694 in QE Mar-19. However, postpaid MOU per subscriber per month declined from 711 in QE Dec-18 to 641 in QE Mar-19.

16. Gross Revenue⁷ (GR) and Adjusted Gross Revenue⁸ (AGR) of Telecom Service Sector for the QE Mar-19 has been ₹58,414 Crore and ₹35,932 Crore respectively. GR declined by 0.98% and AGR declined by 0.34% in QE Mar-19 as compared to previous quarter.

⁵ ARPU per month is calculated by dividing net subscribers' revenue by average number of subscribers.

⁶ MOU per subscriber per month is calculated by dividing total minutes of usage (incoming & outgoing) by average number of subscribers.

⁷ 1. Gross Revenue is inclusive of installation charges, late fees, sale proceeds of handsets (or any other terminal equipment etc.), revenue on account of interest, dividend, value added services, supplementary services, access or interconnection charges, roaming charges, revenue from permissible sharing of infrastructure and any other miscellaneous revenue, without any set-off for related item of expense etc.

⁸ Adjusted Gross Revenue: The following shall be excluded from the Gross Revenue to arrive at the AGR:

- I. PSTN related call charges (Access Charges) actually paid to other eligible/entitled telecommunication service providers within India;

17. The year-on-year (Y-O-Y) growth in GR and AGR in QE Mar-19 over the same quarter in last year has been -6.08% and 0.66% respectively.
18. Pass-through⁹ charges declined from ₹22,936 Crore in QE Dec-18 to ₹22,482 Crore in QE Mar-19. The quarterly and the year-on-year (Y-O-Y) growth rates of pass-through charges for QE Mar-19 are -1.98% and -15.17% respectively.
19. The License Fee¹⁰ declined from ₹2,890 Crore for the QE Sep-18 to ₹2,888 Crore for the QE Mar-18. The quarterly and the year-on-year (Y-O-Y) growth rates of license fee are -0.08% and -1.52% respectively in this quarter.
20. Access services contributed 72.62% of the total Adjusted Gross Revenue of telecom services. In Access services, Gross Revenue (GR), Adjusted Gross Revenue (AGR), License Fee and Pass Through Charges increased by 0.29%, 0.10%, 0.46%, 0.60% respectively in QE Mar-19. However, Spectrum Usage Charges (SUC)¹¹ declined quarterly by 0.70% during the same period.



¹⁰ License Fee means a fee payable by Licensee at prescribed intervals and rates for the period of the Licence.

¹¹ Spectrum Usage Charge is payable by the licensees providing mobile access services, as a percentage of their Adjusted Gross Revenue (AGR).

21. Monthly Average Revenue per User (ARPU) for Access Services based on AGR, declined from ₹72.82 in QE Dec-18 to ₹72.49 in QE Mar-19.
22. The performance of Cellular Mobile service providers in terms of Quality of Service (QoS) during the quarter vis-à-vis that in the previous quarter is given as below:

24. A total number of 902 private satellite TV channels have been permitted by the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting (MIB) for uplinking only/downlinking only/uplinking and downlinking both, as on 31st March, 2019.
25. As per the reporting to TRAI, done by broadcaster in pursuance of the Tariff Order (Broadcasting & Cable), dated 3rd March 2017, there are 328 pay channels as on 31st March, 2019, which include 229 SD (standard definition) pay TV channels and 99 HD (high definition) Pay TV channels.
26. Since its introduction in the year 2003, DTH (direct-to-home) service has displayed a phenomenal growth. During the QE 31st December, 2018, there were 5 pay DTH service providers in the country.

27. DTH has attained net active subscriber base of around 72.44 million in QE 31st March, 2019. This is in addition the subscribers of free DTH services of Doordarshan.
28. Apart from the radio stations operated by All India Radio, the public broadcaster, as on 31st March, 2019, there are 356 operational private FM Radio stations in 98 cities with operational 33 Private FM Radio broadcaster as compared to 355 private FM Radio Stations in 97 cities with operational 33 FM Radio broadcasters in the previous quarter.
29. As per data received from MIB, as on 31st March, 2019, 251 Community Radio Stations are operational.

Introduction

This Report presents the Key Parameters and growth trends for the Telecom Services in India for the quarter ending 31st March, 2019. It provides a broad perspective on the Telecom Services to serve as a reference document for various stakeholders, research agencies and analysts. Chapter-1 depicts the growth pattern, in terms of Subscriber base and Tele-density of Wireline, Wireless, Internet and Value Added Services (VAS) as well as Wireless Data Usage. Chapter-2 covers the key revenue and usage parameters. Chapter-3 gives the financial and accounting data. Chapter-4 covers performance of various telecom service providers in terms of QoS. The information relating to Cable TV, DTH & Radio Broadcast services is provided in Chapter-5.

Section A : Access Service - An Overview

1.1 The number of telephone subscribers in India declined from 1,197.87 million at the end of Dec-18 to 1,183.51 million at the end of Mar-19, registering a decline rate of 1.20% over the previous quarter. This reflects year-on-year (Y-O-Y) growth rate of -1.88% over the same quarter of last year. The overall Teledensity in India declined from 91.45 at the end of Dec-18 to 90.11 at the end of Mar-19.

Chart 1.1: Trends in Telephone Subscribers and Tele-density in India




- 1.2 Telephone subscription in Urban areas increased from 666.28 million at the end of Dec-18 to 669.16 million at the end of Mar-19, however Urban Tele-density slightly declined from 159.98 to 159.96 at the end of the quarter.
- 1.3 Rural telephone subscription declined from 531.59 million at the end of Dec-18 to 514.35 million at the end of Mar-19 and Rural Tele-density also declined from 59.50 at the end of Dec-18 to 57.47 at the end of Mar-19.
- 1.4 The year-on-year(Y-O-Y) growth rate of Urban and Rural telephone subscription from Mar-18 to Mar-19 is -1.83% and -1.96% respectively. Year-on-year (Y-o-Y) growth rate of Urban and Rural Tele-density from Mar-18 to Mar-19 is -3.58% and -2.69% respectively.

Chart 1.4: Composition of Rural-Urban Telephone Subscription at the end of the quarter





- 1.8 The net decline in telephone subscribers is 14.36 million in Q.E. Mar-19 as compared to the net addition of 6.46 million subscribers in Q.E. Dec-18.

- 1.13 Total Wireless (GSM including LTE+CDMA) subscriber base declined from 1,176.00 million at the end of Dec-18 to 1,161.81 million at the end of Mar-19, thereby showing a quarterly decline rate of 1.21%. During the quarter, net decline of 14.19 million wireless subscribers has been recorded.

- 1.14 Total wireless subscriber base showed year-on-year (Y-O-Y) growth rate of -1.82% in Q1 Mar-19 over same quarter in previous year.

1.15 Wireless Teledensity declined from 89.78 at the end of Dec-18 to 88.46 at the end of Mar-19.

Chart 1.6: Wireless Subscriber Base and Teledensity



1.19 M/s Vodafone Idea Ltd is still a leading operator with market share of 33.98% in total wireless subscription at the end of Mar-19, despite loosing of 23.91 million wireless subscribers during the quarter. M/s Bharti Airtel held second position with 325.18 million wireless subscribers at the end of Mar-19.



- 1.22 Volume of total wireless data usage increased from 14,283,256 terabytes during Q.E. Dec-18 to 15,850,560 terabytes during Q.E. Mar-19. Out of total data wireless usage, 2G data usage was 96,560 terabytes, 3G data usage was 1,299,074 terabyte and 4G data usage was 14,454,925 terabytes during the quarter. CDMA data usage was remained 0.01 terabytes only during the QE Mar-19.

- 1.23 Total number of wireless data subscribers increased from 578.20 million at the end of Dec-18 to 613.75 million at the end of Mar-19.



- 1.33 Number of VPTs declined from 1,32,832* at the end of Dec-18 to 1,30,376 at the end of Mar-19 with quarterly decline rate of 1.53%. However, it shows yearly decline of 34.50% in QE Mar-19 over same quarter in previous year.
- 1.34 As per the information received in TRAI, at the end of Mar-19, only M/s BSNL was providing VPT in the country. Service area wise detailed table of VPT is available at Annexure -1.4.

Section D: Internet Service

1.35 This section summarizes information submitted by 332 internet service providers for the quarter ending Mar-19. **Part-I** consists of information of Internet service (narrowband+broadband), **Part-II** consists of broadband service and **Part-III** covers narrowband service.

Part-I : Internet Service (broadband + narrowband)

1.36 As per reports received from 332 operators as compared to 326 operators in last quarter, total number of internet subscribers increased from 604.21 million at the end of Dec-18 to 636.73 million at the end of Mar-19 with quarterly growth rate of 5.38%. Out of total 636.73 million internet subscribers, 563.31 million were broadband subscribers and 73.42 million were narrowband subscribers.

1.37 Wired Internet subscribers increased from 21.42 million at the end of Dec-18 to 21.68 million at the end of Mar-19 with quarterly growth rate of 1.19%. Wireless Internet subscribers increased from 582.79 million at the end of Dec-18 to 615.05 million at the end of Mar-19 with quarterly growth rate of 5.54%.

1.38 The number of Broadband subscribers increased from 525.36 million at the end of Dec-18 to 563.31 million at the end of Mar-19 with quarterly growth rate of 7.22%. However, the number of Narrowband subscribers declined from 78.86 million at the end of Dec-18 to 73.42 million at the end of Mar-19 with quarterly growth rate of -6.89%.





Chart 1.9: Composition of Internet subscription









Chart 1.19 : Composition of Wireless Internet subscription




Chart 1.20 : Technology trend for Wireless Internet Access





Chart 1.21 : Technology trend for Wired Internet Access



Chart 1.22 : Trends in MOU for Internet Telephony





- 1.53 In wired broadband segment, BSNL holds 50% market share with 9.21 million subscribers followed by Bharti with 2.36 million subscribers.
- 1.54 In wireless broadband segment, Reliance Jio holds 56.29% market share with 306.72 million subscribers followed by Bharti Airtel Ltd (20.60%) with 112.26 million subscribers.

Chart 1.23 : Composition of Broadband subscription – Technology wise







Chart 2.3 : Minutes of Usage by Out-roamers as a % of Total Minutes of Usage





Chart 2.4: Outgoing SMS Usage by Out-roamers as a % of Total No. of Outgoing SMS Usage











A. Satellite TV Channels

- 5.1 A total of 902 private satellite TV channels have been permitted by the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting (MIB) for uplinking only/downlinking only/uplinking and downloading both, as on 31st March, 2019. The quarter-wise figures in the total number of TV channels depicted in below chart.


Chart 5.1: Quarterly growth in number of Satellite TV channels (FTA & Pay) registered with Ministry of I&B



B. Pay TV Channels

- 5.2 Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI), in March, 2017, notified the new regulatory framework for Broadcasting and Cable services. The framework comprises of Tariff Order 2017, Interconnection Regulations 2017 and Quality of Service & Consumer Protection Regulations 2017. The framework was duly notified vide press release no.71/2018 dated 3rd July 2018 with revised timelines for implementation. All the timelines prescribed in the above-mentioned framework commenced from 3rd July 2018. The new regulatory framework has come into effect on 29th December 2018.
- 5.3 As per the Telecommunication (Broadcasting and Cable) Services (Eighth) (Addressable Systems) Tariff Order, 2017 dated 3rd March 2017, every broadcaster has to offer all its channels on a-la-carte basis to all distributors of television channels and declare maximum retail price, per month, payable by a subscriber for each of its pay channel offered on a-la-carte basis. Further, it is also permissible for a broadcaster to offer its pay channels in the form of bouquet and declare the maximum retail price, per month, of such bouquet payable by a subscriber.
- 5.4 As per the reporting done by broadcasters in pursuance of the Tariff Order dated 3rd March 2017, there are 328 pay channels, as on 31st March, 2019, which include 229 SD pay TV channels and 99 HD Pay TV channels. A list of Maximum Retail Prices (MRP) of pay channels offered by broadcasters for subscribers as reported to TRAI is attached as **Annexure-5.1**

C. Cable TV Sector

- 5.5 Digitization, with addressability, of cable TV sector has been completed. The country achieved 100% digitization of Cable TV network. This is a stupendous achievement making India as the only large country where 100% digital cable has been achieved through mandatory regulations. As on 31st March 2019, there are 1,469 Multi System Operators (MSOs) registered with Ministry of Information and Broadcasting (MIB).

D. Direct-to-Home (DTH) Sector

- 5.6 Since its introduction in the year 2003, Indian DTH service has displayed a phenomenal growth. During the quarter ending 31st March, 2019, there were 5 pay DTH service providers in India.
- 5.7 DTH has attained net active subscriber base of around 72.44 million with 5 pay DTH service providers as on 31st March, 2019 as compared to 70.49 million at the end of last quarter. This is in

addition to the subscribers of the free DTH services of Doordarshan. Quarterly growth in the DTH sector in terms of the net active subscriber base and Market Share of DTH operators in terms of the percentage of net active subscribers during the quarter is depicted in the following charts.

Chart 5.3 : Quarterly growth in Net Active subscribers (in million) of pay DTH





Chart 5.4 : Market share of DTH Operators




E. FM Radio Services

- 5.8 Apart from the radio stations operated by All India Radio- the public broadcaster, as on 31st March 2019, there are 356 operational private FM Radio stations in 98 cities with operational 33 Private FM Radio broadcaster as compared to 355 private FM Radio Stations in 97 cities with operational 33 FM Radio broadcasters in the previous quarter. A list of 98 existing cities with operational private FM radio channels in India as on 31st March, 2019 is placed at **Annexure 5.3**.
- 5.9 During the quarter ending 31st March, 2019, one new private FM Radio Station has become operational. The detail of new private FM Radio station is as under:-



Chart 5.6 : Quarterly growth in FM Radio Advertisement Revenue


