Sub: Telecom sector policy on IUC fees

Dear Sir,

With regard to Interconnection Usage Charge (IUC) regime, it is learnt the TRAI has invited stakeholders view to review the 2017 notification where it notified that IUC regime will pave way to Bill and Keep regime and IUC charges will be made zero paise from the current 6 paise per minute.

The consumers are suffered a lot due to IUC charges as the operators takes away the money from the consumers in an indirect manner. The incumbent operators are also providing services under 2G and 3G network and not keen to provide 4G facilities.

The incumbent operator's view that the consumers are not shifting to 4G services despite having 4G VoLTE devices is wrong and fabricated. The consumers across the country are refrained from 4G services. It is wrong to state that consumer chooses not to activate the feature for voice calls.
