Sir,

As per the latest India mobile congress the regulator has already sought comments from industry on (IUC), and would conduct an open house discussing before arriving at a decision.

Two years ago, the regulator had brought down from 14 paisa per minute to 6 paisa per minute and decided to scrap the charge from January 2020, deferring the implementation of the zero-IUC regime, saying millions of subscribers have still not moved to Voice over LTE (VoLTE), which was expected to lower the cost of generating a call, rendering IUC redundant.

Therefore, ending IUC would not only help us with reduce tariff but also de-incentivize old operators for not upgrading to 4G network.
