Here are my responses for the questions raised in the TRAI's consultation note dated Nov 15th 2016.

- A1. The architecture suggested by the TRAI is a good starting point for the discussions on a national standard for authentication and payment interoperability, but not sufficient.
- A2. More time requested.
- A3. Yes, it should be possible for public wi-fi providers to provide their services with a minimum of regulation sufficient to ensure security compliance. This will enable more people and entities to set up public wi-fi hotspots.
- A4. At the access level, anybody should be able to resell their Internet connection to other users by means of setting up a public wi-fi hotspot that is in compliance with security requirements.
