We are a small regional MSO operating in various towns of Uttar Pradesh. While we welcome the TRAI's implementation of NTO, the purpose of bringing parity among all MSO as it relates to the Broadcasting fees charged by the Pay TV Broadcasters has been completely lost. It seems most of the pay Broadcasters have done a side deal with all the major national MSOs to keep their content subscription fees very low as compared to the smaller MSOs.

Our suggestion is that TRAI should ask for written undertaking/affidavit from the CEO of each pay broadcasters that they have not done any side deals with the major national MSOs to circumvent/abuse the NTO regulations.
